



Kurt stressed that the focus of the team is to make baseball fun. The mission is Fans First and Entertain always. One of the first decisions focusing on Fans First was to include all you can eat in the price of a ticket. A ticket is \$35 and there is no extra cost for food, taxes, etc. The merchandise price includes taxes, fees and shipping if purchased on-line.

The team has grown tremendously in the last few years over social media. It has more Tik Tok followers than any other major sports team in the country. When they transitioned out of the CPL and began a full season, they created 11 rules to make the game faster. They have also removed advertising from the stadium. When new ideas are put forth, they ask three questions: Is it fans first? Does it make baseball fun? Is it shareable – something people talk about and put on social media.

Kurt joined Savannah Bananas in 2021 as the 12th staff member. Now there are 64 staff members. They are building the brand using a couple of concepts. One is to eliminate the fear of failure. They always want to try new things. Secondly is to build relationships and create loyalty. Kurt meets with over 350 groups in all the cities where the team plays and builds a relationship with them. Kyle noted that the players also are encouraged to connect with at least one fan during each game.
