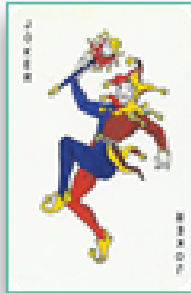

January 30 Meeting**Ken Jacobsen****ACT Three**

Ken shared information about a 2-1/2 day local retreat he's developed called Act Three, which explores the question, how do we express the very best of ourselves during our encore years? What if we could make our third act the best one yet? As he said, I'm old but I'm not done!

He loosely described our 3 acts in life, from birth to age 21, the middle years where we build our lives from career to family to personal security, and the third Act as our retirement years.

Act Three Retreat has three main concepts:

1. Stay the course. You've earned the good life, enjoy it.
2. The future ain't what it used to be, the paradox of having more time than ever, yet less time remaining.
3. Exploring our secret identity – a fun way to describe looking inside to find one more thing you might do that you are passionate about.

The retreat takes place in the village. It is a small group experience with no lectures, electronics, apps etc., what he called an intimate human experience. Time is spent on identifying personal values, passions, gifts and talents, and our unique life purpose. Ken shared examples of what this means to him. His top value is integrity, his gifts and passions of working with others to help make each other's lives better while at the same time expanding our own, a combined purpose that matters deeply to him.
