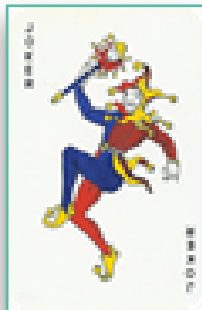

**Bryan Bennett
LiveOak Fiber**



Bryan gave us some background information on LiveOak Fiber. It is a new internet service provider based in Brunswick with a 100% fiber-optic infrastructure. They acquired ATC and have a 3-year build-out plan for Glynn County and Okaloosa County in Florida. It is privately funded and the goal is to get 180,000 passings (home or business connections) in 3 years. They have also created new jobs in Glynn and will have

more over the next few years. They are 90% complete in downtown Brunswick, 50% in Harry Driggers, about 60% in St. Simons, 100% in Blythe Island, and just broke ground on Sea Island.

LiveOak has packages that start at 500Mbps & up to 5Gbps both upload and download with no data caps or contracts. There is also greater network reliability. The max speed of current providers is 1Gbps with much slower upload speeds. The packages start at \$55 and include equipment.

If you wish to have LiveOak connect to your house, Bryan recommends flagging irrigation lines and sprinkler heads if you know where they are. But LiveOak will repair any damage that might occur.
