From the north:

- Take Andrews Avenue South to Eller Drive (Andrews curves into Eller Dr.) under US 1 overpass east toward the Port
- Make first left onto SE 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue (there's no street sign) but look for Cliff Berry sign (do not stop at the the CBI building at the intersection)
- Continue north on SE 9<sup>th</sup> Ave to dead end (before gate)
- Make a right into CBI industrial complex (past Princess Parking)
- Make immediate left in parking area and continue further north until you see a big canvas structure (no sides)
