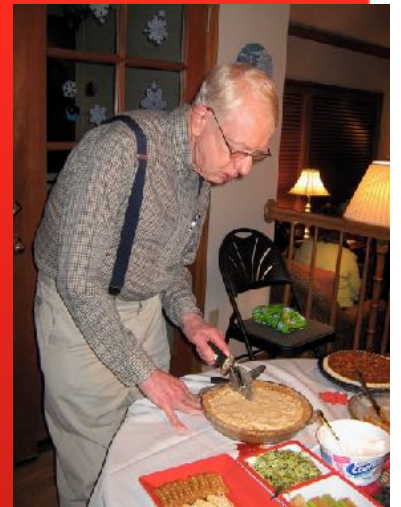

The stalwart crew in the photo below did a great job of getting Trinity Place grounds into shape for spring. Photos at right give you an idea of the "before" vs "after".



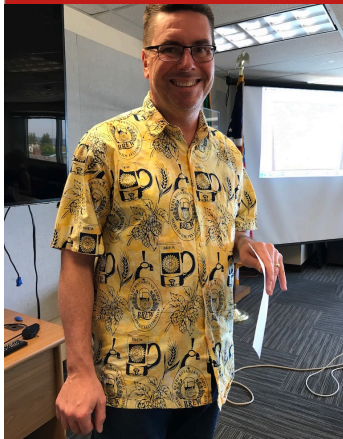
