


Presidents' Message



\$4,000 Rotary Grant to North Eugene High School



The Rotary Club of Eugene (Club) has awarded a \$4,000 District Grant to the North Eugene High School (NEHS) sophomore Social Studies team! With this grant, all 2022-2023 sophomores at NEHS will be able to attend the annual NEHS Global Issues Conference (GIC) in March 2023 on the University of Oregon campus. Over the course of several months GIC participants will research issues facing the world including women's rights, climate change and nuclear proliferation. They will explore solutions to complex issues and develop nation-state positions on the issues. Their work will culminate in the day-long GIC at the UO where the issues will be debated, resulting in difficult negotiations leading to treaties designed to solve these issues. The Club is excited to provide NEHS sophomores with this opportunity to hone their leadership and collaboration skills at a University venue – providing the students with the opportunity to picture themselves studying and succeeding on a real college campus!


