

## **TODAY'S PROGRAM**

Holly Hood, Executive Director and Curator, Healdsburg Museum and Historical Society.

Today's talk: *African Americans in Healdsburg* 

Current exhibit at Museum is a Free Exhibit: African Americans in California and Healdsburg
Ms. Hood shared with the Club that she had invested 25 years in deep



research of the subject matter discovered there were 72 African Americans in 1857 in Sonoma County, 27 were identified as farmers, 26 of the 27 were claimed slaves.

Ms. Hood provided many examples of notable African Americans who settled in Healdsburg and made a difference. Among the ones highlighted, Smith "Smity" Robinson, was a standout as a Rotarian. Robinson published a newsletter, "Smity's Scoop", and with our Club's assistance sent the newsletter and care packages to members of our Nation's Armed Services. **Jerry Ogden** announced to the Club, Smity will be one of the 50



deceased members to be recognized with a personal brick around the Rotary Club of Healdsburg Memorial Bench.
