Anne was at a dinner party next to a lady who was doing a study of women who had never used a dishwasher. After trying the product for a month that she did not know it was Ivory Liquid since it did not have a Product label on the bottle. As a result, she ended up on a TV commercial to praise the product Ivory liquid. Proctor & Gamble owns the Ivory Liquid detergent. After being on commercials many longtime friends would contact her. She was shown on talk shows and soap operas. With sales

going up they wanted to make new commercials for which she went to NY to make commercials on TV for 1 ½ years. From there she got an agent to be on other commercials and she did that on other print work advertising not on TV. After many years she wanted to go into teaching so went to school to get her graduate degree and credential and was able to pay off all student loans.
