Foundation Board - Chair John King invited members interested in becoming Trustees of the Board to talk to him if they are interested in filling one of the three vacating positions for a 3-year term.

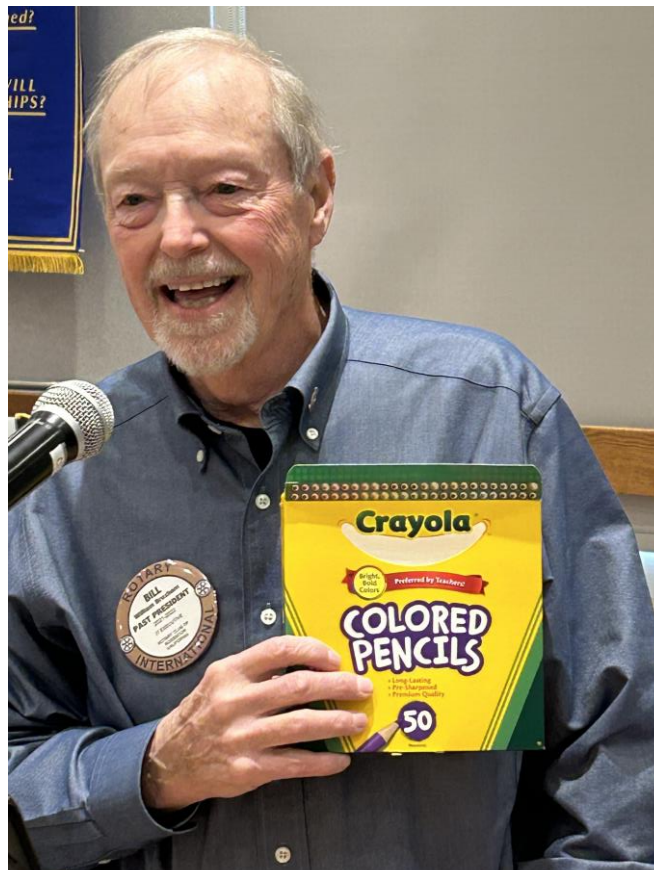
PROGRAM
