
PROGRAM

Speakers were Andy Chu and Peter Li on Understanding anti-Asian racism. A strongly appreciated presentation to our members. Both men are immigrants to this country. Peter and Andy expressed their gratitude for being in America, and both acknowledged that our country was the best place in the world to achieve successful careers and status, and how much they loved living at Rossmoor. Yet, as Peter described anti-Asian racism is not new in the U.S. and that is exacerbated by economic disparity, heated political rhetoric, and negative media portrayals. For Peter the key to alleviating this negativity is to find means of communication and understanding the fear of Chinese assimilations. Just think of our love of Chinese food and the popularity of using chopsticks in overcoming such fears. Peter quoted Ronald Reagan, "You can come to America and become American." The pillars to build against anti-Asian racism are dialogue, understanding, and compassion.

Andy immigrated to the U.S. sixty years ago. He was given numerous opportunities to achieve the American Dream. He has never personally encountered direct racism; nevertheless he acknowledged that Asians face considerable turmoil in part by being blamed for causing Covid-19. As president of the Chinese American Association of Rossmoor, Andy has been a leader in the establishment of successful diversity programs at Rossmoor. It is his way of communicating and educating us so that we understand all of us belong right here. Andy then showed a wonderful video with this as its theme.
