Joy presented some additional facts (a few shown here).

- 1. Pennsylvania is the only state that observes Flag Day as a state holiday.
- 2. The Flag has been changed 27 times. The final star for Hawaii was added in 1960.
- 3. The Flag should not be flown at night without a light on it.

4. The designer of the American Flag was Francis Hopkinson, a signer of the Declaration of Independence as a delegate from New Jersey.

5. There are 6 American flags on the moon. Five are standing, but Neil Armstrong's fell over.

6. The Flag should not be flown in the rain or inclement weather.

7. After a tragedy or death, the flag is flown at half-staff for 30 days. It's called "half-staff "on land, and "half-mast" on a ship.

8. Betsy Ross sewed the first American Flag.

9. The Flag Code bans the use of the flag as clothing. That's right, not USA T-Shirts, bandanas, or bikinis. 10. If you like to study flags, then you are a Vexillologist.
