The Park District covers two counties (Alameda and Contra Costa) and operates 73 parks. In the two counties, there are no county-run parks. Of the 73 parks, four are located in Oakland. They are Sibley Volcanic Regional Preserve, Roberts Regional Recreation Area, Reinhardt Redwood Regional Park, and Martin Luther King Jr. Regional Shoreline.

Ms. Landreth is a former City Administrator for Oakland and City Manager of Emeryville. She received her Master's degree in Public Policy Analysis from UC Berkeley.
