President Joe awarded "Rotary on the Run" medals to Sakura and Samantha.




Happy August Birthdays

New Sergeant at Arms

President Joe announced that the only member who has carte blanche to speak out at club meetings is Sergeant at Arms **Jason Wizelman**. **Jason** will assist in keeping order and adding to the fun at meetings.

Speaker for the Day—Kristi McKenney

Isaac Kos-Read returned to the lectern to introduce member **Kristi McKenney**. **Kristi** assumed the position of executive director of the Port of Oakland on March 1, 2025. She is the first woman to serve as Port executive director in its ninety-eight-year history. She previously served as COO and assistant aviation director.

Kristi provided an overview of the Port and updates to the port, airport, and real estate operations:

- The Port is an independent department of the City of Oakland. It does not receive any funds from the City and pays taxes and for City services.
- The seaport is the waterfront agency and has 1,300 acres
- The Port either owns or has jurisdiction over Jack London Square, Embarcadero Cove, Brooklyn Basin, Martin Luther King Jr. Regional Shoreline, and the Airport Business Park
- The airport opened in 1927 and consists of 2,600 acres
- Southwest Airlines is the largest private employer in Oakland
- The seaport is the number one refrigerated export port in the world
- The seaport is a "balanced" port with 50% imports and 50% exports
- All ships at berth have shore power
- Passengers can fly to Europe from OAK (ask Kristi for details)

- The new airport name (Oakland San Francisco Bay Airport) identifies the airport geographically
- The airport is elevating the airport experience with new shops, restaurants and five-star restrooms
- The Port's commercial real estate is the most challenging operation
