Equine Path to Hope in Lemoore, CA is a therapeutic riding center that provides equine-assisted therapy, horseback riding lessons, and natural horsemanship programs for children and adults, including those with special needs.

Overview

Path to Hope is a nonprofit organization founded in 2019 and recognized for its contributions to youth development in Kings County, California. The center offers personalized sessions designed to foster meaningful connections between participants and horses, aiming to enhance mental, physical, and emotional health.

Services Offered

Equine Assisted Therapy and Equine Assisted Learning for people of all ages and abilities.
Beginner and introductory horseback riding lessons focusing on natural horsemanship techniques.
Support for individuals with autism and other special needs, helping them build skills and confidence.
All sessions are individualized and paced to match each participant's goals.

Leadership and Horses

The center is led by Gabrielle Godinho, who is certified in equine assisted learning and psychotherapy and has over 25 years of horse experience.

The horse team includes therapy horses like Shorty, Junior, Chief, and Daisy, each with unique personalities and training backgrounds.



Share biometrics

Letting your partner unlock your phone with their Face ID or a fingerprint means no fumbling for passcodes. Great in emergencies or when one of you is driving.

iPhone: Go to Settings > Face ID & Passcode (or Touch ID & Passcode). Enter your passcode, tap Set Up an Alternate Appearance (Face ID) or Add a Fingerprint (Touch ID), and scan your partner.

Android: Settings vary but generally go to Settings > Security & privacy > Device lock or Biometrics > Face recognition or Fingerprints. Add a new face or fingerprint and follow the prompts.

Set up emergency contacts

This makes sure your partner's number shows up for first responders even if your phone is locked.

iPhone: Open the Health app > Profile icon (upper-right corner) > Medical ID > Edit. Scroll to Emergency Contacts > Edit > Add Emergency Contact, select your partner, and save.

Android: Open the Contacts app, pick your partner, and mark as Emergency Contact. Some phones (like Pixel or Samsung) also have Settings > Safety and emergency > Emergency contacts for more options.






