### **SAM HALE**

Mt. Wilson Observatory's Enduring Legacy to Pasadena

**INTRODUCER:** Alan Schier



Sam Hale was born in Pasadena in 1942. He is the grandson of George Ellery Hale, who founded the Mount Wilson Observatory in 1904. Although Sam didn't know his grandfather personally, his earliest memory is of being a seven-year-old, in awe of the giant telescopes designed and built by G.E. Hale.

Sam attended Polytechnic School and then the Cate School in Carpinteria for high school. He earned a BA in History in 1964 and an MBA in Finance in 1966, both at UC Berkeley. His career has spanned fifty eight years in the investment field with Standard&Poors, Hillside Associates (a private investment firm) and currently Century Management of Austin, Texas. Sam and his wife Sylvia have lived in Santa Barbara the last twelve years since moving from Pasadena.

They have one son, Gavin, who lives in New York City.

Sam is a Past President of the Pasadena Humane Society, and is currently Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Mount Wilson Institute, which manages the Mount Wilson Observatory on behalf of the Carnegie Institution for Science. The Mount Wilson Institute is dedicated to preserving the Observatory for scientific research and fostering public appreciation of the historic cultural heritage of the Observatory.




