MAY 8 RECAP: Annual Community Grants, Wally Rosvall, Chair

Community Grants is a major outreach effort of our club. This year, under the leadership of Wally Rosvall, the committee disbursed \$27,000 to 10 different non-profit organizations, all of whom sent a representative to receive their checks and explain the intended use of the grant money. The organizations are:

Cancer Treatment Center, East Meets West Parent Education Club, Families Forward Learning Center, Give Mentor Love, JARAY Fullerton Civic Light Opera, Pasadena Village, San Gabriel Valley Literacy Council, The Huntington Library student transportation fund, Young & Healthy, Villa Esperanza.

\$20,000 of the funding came from Rotary Charities (which receives money from the Motor Classic) and \$7500 came from the district (which is returning a portion of the money we donated previously to the district).


