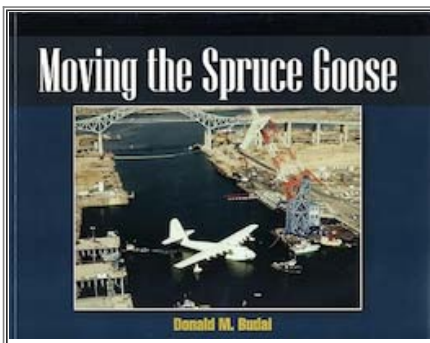

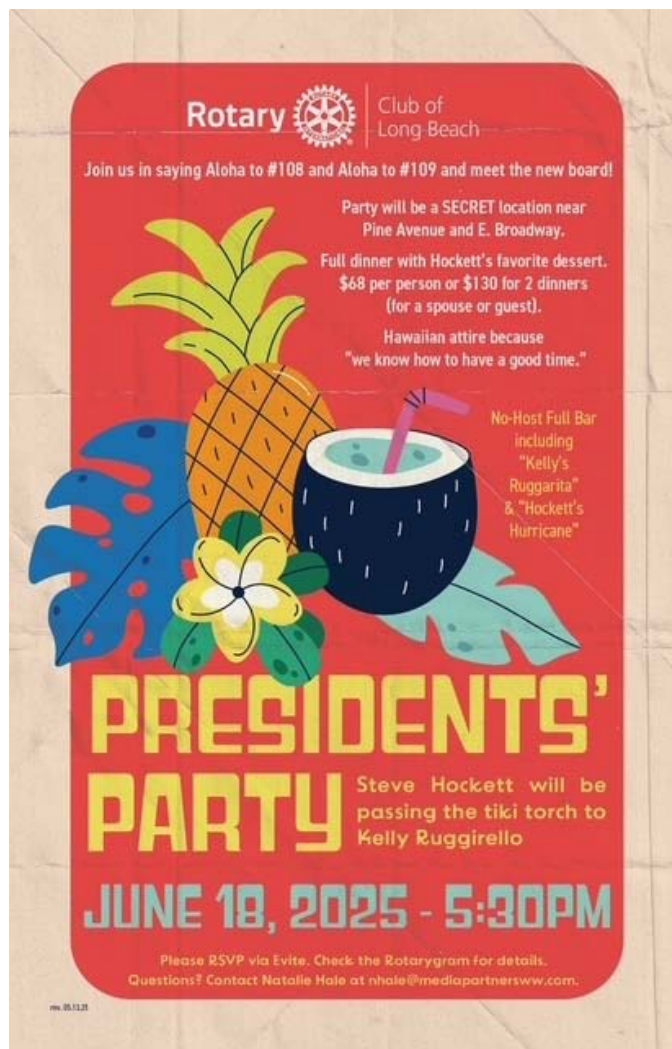

For 2025, grants will range from \$2,500 to \$5,000 per project. If a Grant is awarded, the recipient must report back with photos (MINIMUM OF FIVE PHOTOGRAPHS) no later than 60 days from the completion of the funded Project. Project must occur before December 31, 2025. If a Grant is awarded, the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation logo must be placed on any and all marketing and promotional materials for the project/event, on any and all signage for the event and on any and all clothing for the project/event. Thank you so very much for awarding our TK class at MacArthur Elementary a \$500 grant toward reading development. The money was able to cover a brand new library of books that the children were excited about in subjects that they were interested in. We were also able to buy them fun reading pointers to identify sight words, and track read, as well as magnetic letters and a magnetic easel to promote sight word learning, and a reader's theater to demonstrate reading comprehension. I am excited to announce that this year our classroom library was very popular at choice time and 95% of my students were able to read all 15 TK sight words by May. This is a large jump from previous years at 80% in May.
