

Speaker - Jennifer Armand - Bayou Community Foundation



Bayou Community Foundation Executive Director Jennifer Armand was named to her post in December 2012, shortly after the Foundation was established to serve the coastal Louisiana communities of Lafourche, Terrebonne and Grand Isle.

In this role, Jennifer is responsible for managing and implementing the Foundation's operations, including BCF's annual nonprofit grant programs, nonprofit workshops and conferences, donor relations and fund development, communications, community needs assessments and issue advocacy.

Through the COVID pandemic and Hurricanes Ida and Francine, Jennifer has managed over \$12 million in grants awarded to local nonprofits for critical relief and recovery programs serving the most impacted residents of this vulnerable community, as well as fund development and program management of the innovative and impactful Rebuild the Bayou housing recovery programs in Terrebonne, Lafourche and Grand Isle that have built 54 new homes and repaired over nearly 500 homes for under-resourced storm survivors.

Jennifer earned her Bachelor of Arts in Journalism from Louisiana State University, and has worked as a radio news director in Lake Charles, Press Secretary for the LA Dept. of Environmental Quality, Public Affairs Coordinator for Georgia Gulf in Plaquemine, and as a public relations consultant for the Armand Creative firm she and her husband Matthew founded in Houma.

A member of the Lafourche, Thibodaux and Houma-Terrebonne Chambers of Commerce, Jennifer served as Chair of the Houma-Terrebonne Chamber in 2013. She is a graduate of the Leadership Terrebonne class of 1998, a member of the pastoral council of the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux, and a volunteer at St. Anthony of Padua church in Bayou Black.

Leading Bayou Community Foundation over the past decade, Jennifer's love for the special people, places and culture of the Bayou Region grows stronger every day, and she is one of this precious community's biggest champions.


