

#### **Guest Speakers - Kimber Ratcliff with Second Harvest Food Bank**



Kimber Ratcliff is the Development Officer for Second Harvest in the Bayou Region, which includes Terrebonne, Lafourche, and Grand Isle. After years as a volunteer helping those experiencing food insecurity in our area, she now works fulltime in development to share with community members the often hidden hunger crisis and how Second Harvest works with our local nonprofits to address the need in the Bayou. Second Harvest has been serving the Bayou Region for 40 years. In Lafourche Parish, Terrebonne Parish, and Grand Isle, communitybased food pantries rely on drives from local organizations, postal drives, and individual donations. Those supplies only meet a small portion of the needs in our communities. That's where Second Harvest comes in. Second Harvest receives millions of pounds of donated food from the USDA, retail grocery stores, food manufacturers, farmers, and other large donors. By

delivering these truckloads of nonperishable foods, meat, fresh produce, and dairy, Second Harvest fills the gap for our partner food agencies, usually providing about 80% of the food distributed by local food pantries. Second Harvest also provides resources for programs such as after-school snacks, summer feeding, mobile pantries, and extensive disaster relief.

Due to the continued recovery from Hurricane Ida and the effects of inflation on families, Second Harvest is making long-term investments in the Bayou region by opening a local warehouse to serve as a distribution facility for our work. A new warehouse will allow us to route deliveries directly to Houma, expand food deliveries for the region from 1-2 a day to 3-4 a day, and greatly increase the number of pounds of food distributed each year in Lafourche, Terrebonne, and Grand Isle. This facility will also provide a local location for residents to drop off food donations for Second Harvest and create the opportunity for the food bank to collect donations from local grocery stores and other food retailers. The warehouse will transform our ability to reach the highest-needed areas of the Bayou region in times of disaster and better serve our partner agencies and neighbors year-round.

## **ROD - Earl J Eues, Jr. - Director of Terrebonne Parish Homeland Security**

Mr. Earl Eues, Director of the Terrebonne Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness. Mr. Eues holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Biological Sciences from Nicholls State University and has over 33 years of experience in the environmental regulatory field and various emergency response/coordination experience. Mr. Eues has been the director of the Terrebonne Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness since 2008 and under the administration of Parish President Gordon Dove, Mr. Eues coordinates the day-to-day and emergency operations of the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness for the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government. Since his appointment as director, he has managed the following major



events affecting

Terrebonne Parish: Hurricane Gustav, Hurricane Ike, Hurricane Isaac, Hurricane Barry. In 2020, the Terrebonne Parish EOC was activated four times for Hurricane Marco, Laura, Delta and Zeta. In 2021, Tropical Storm Claudette and Hurricane Ida. Mr. Eues also managed all Parish operations during the 2009 BP Oil Spill in the Gulf of Mexico and the current COVID-19 health emergency which began in 2020.

Mr. Eues is the former Region 3 Regional Director and chairperson of the Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness regional subcommittee, former board member of the Louisiana Emergency Preparedness Association, current board member of the Region 3 Louisiana Emergency Response Network and a commission member of the Terrebonne General Health System. Mr. Eues is also the owner of KEE Environmental Services, L.L.C., a environmental consulting business based in Houma, Louisiana.
