"What Makes The Greater Dayton School the Most Innovative School in America"



The Greater Dayton School is Ohio's first private non-religious school strictly for under-resourced students. It opened in 2022 and has drawn national attention for its whole-child, long-term approach to education. The school was started by The Connor Group Kids & Community Partners, the non-profit arm of a local real estate investment firm. Ryan Ernst, a partner in the firm, will outline the school's unique approach to pulling kids out of generational poverty.

Rotary on the Road: Dayton Children's - submitted by Kim Bramlage



Jena Pado hosted our group and we met in the beautiful Specialty Care Center on the Dayton Children's campus. Dayton Children's is the former "Barney's Children's Hospital" and has come a long way in the last 56 years.

In 2024, they saw 694,000 visits, including to the urgent care, inpatient facilities, emergency department and physician's offices. Children's currently has 412 providers and offers more than 45 specialty services.

In 2022 alone, more than 700 of the children that came to the hospital did so for mental health reasons and they have ramped up their behavioral health services and programs due to the increasing need in the community. Suicide is the second leading cause of death in children ages 10-14.

The new Mathile inpatient facility will focus specifically on pediatric patients (up to age 18) that need mental health treatment and care. It will be a stand-alone hospital with 24 beds and the opportunity to expand to 48 beds in the future. The team that helps children with mental health needs includes therapists, psychologists, psychiatrists, case workers, resiliency coordinators, dieticians, and crisis management staff. This facility will be open in July of this year.

We learned about the organization's strategic and master plan which includes areas such as workforce development, community partnerships, philanthropy, care facilities and management systems.

It was a great opportunity to see and hear about the important work happening at Dayton Children's.



Rotary on the Road: Miami Conservancy District

Rotarians enjoyed a fascinating visit to the Miami Conservancy District, where we explored the legacy of the 1913 Great Flood and learned how it led to the creation of one of the most effective flood protection systems in the world.
