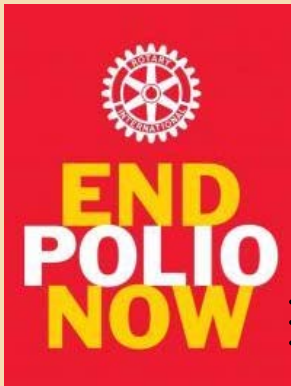
No meeting August 24 due to Golf Outing

Update on Polio in the USA

I'm sure we have all heard about the case of paralytic polio in the USA, specifically in New York State (Rockland County). The unvaccinated person with polio in Rockland county, NY, has a strain of the virus that occurs when the attenuated (weakened) vaccine strain used in some other countries reverts back to an infectious virus. This reverted virus can then infect unvaccinated people. This is really rare, but can happen. The polio vaccine in the USA uses a killed virus, commonly called IPV (inactivated polio virus) so there is no opportunity for the virus to evolve back to an infective state.

There is an estimate that for every case of paralytic polio, there are at least 100 cases undetected, so local health authorities will monitor the waste of areas where polio is suspected. Polio virus has now been detected in Rockland and Orange counties, as well as New York City, indicating that the virus is circulating in the local, unvaccinated population. Earlier this year, infectious virus was also detected in the waste from London, UK. All of this means that polio is circulating and could still cause problems- and not only in Pakistan, Afghanistan or the African continent.

Who are people most at risk of developing polio?

- Unvaccinated individuals
- Individuals who haven't received the full course of vaccination
- People traveling to high risk areas (CDC recommends that people traveling to Africa, Asia and Eastern Europe who previously completed the regular vaccine schedule get a single, lifetime booster shot)

As we know, there is no cure for polio, but it can be prevented with vaccination. As Rotarians, we are dedicated to eradicating polio- and now that also means we need to continue our advocacy for vaccination efforts- in the USA as well as the rest of the world. We cannot afford to be complacent.
