

# Updating Club ByLaws



#### Westerville Sunrise Club Bylaws

Thanks to **Pat Knott**, **Gene Hollins**, **Julie Colley** and other thought leaders who updated our Club Bylaws and the Club Board who opined on the language.

In accordance with our 1999 bylaws, as well as the proposed 2025 bylaws, all club members will be asked to vote on the revised bylaws, which include a section for the Satellite Club. \*\*That said, *there will not be a separate go/no-go vote on the Satellite Club*.

- Bylaws to be sent to the Club Board for final approval
- If approved by the Club Board, bylaws will be emailed in PDF format to the Club next week
- Voting:
  - We will vote in person, using paper ballots, at the April 30th meeting
  - Anyone who can't attend the April 30th meeting can submit their vote to the Club Secretary in advance
  - Votes will remain anonymous, with the exception of the Club Secretary tracking the votes. We
    need to be able to track who is voting so that people don't accidentally vote twice, since we are
    giving them the option of voting in advance.
  - Votes after 8:30 a.m. on April 30th will not be counted
- After the April 30th meeting, the Club Secretary will tally the results. If we reach a quorum, then we will tabulate the yes / no votes. If two-thirds of the voting members vote yes, the bylaws will be adopted.
