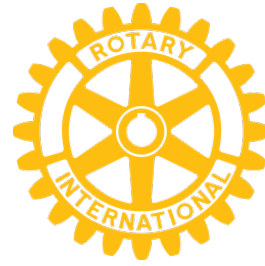

Our recommendation: start a Satellite club as an alternative meeting experience for members who cannot regularly attend weekly meetings. Overview:

- Past Rotary Club Presidents Sue Castro and Heather Linch have volunteered to lead a Satellite club, and Stacey Rusterholz has agreed to be co-chair.
- Two monthly meetings:
 - 2nd Wednesday: Dinner at a local Westerville restaurant
 - Volunteer / Service Event
- Annual dues: consistent amount and timing to collect payment with Sponsor club dues
- Satellite Club Secretary/Treasurer will update DACdb with new member information and maintain bank account for Satellite club

IF approved, the Satellite club will begin on July 1.

Voting:

- We will vote in person, using paper ballots, at the June 4th meeting
- Anyone who can't attend the June 4th meeting can submit their vote to the Club Secretary in advance - angelasillus.rotary@gmail.com
- Votes will remain anonymous, with the exception of the Club Secretary and one Club Board member tracking the votes. We need to be able to track who is voting so that people don't accidentally vote twice since we are giving members an option of voting in advance
- Votes after 8:30 a.m. on June 4th will not be counted
- After the June 4th meeting, the Club Secretary will tally the results. If we reach a quorum, then we will tabulate the yes / no votes. If two-thirds of the voting members vote yes, the Satellite club will be adopted.

- Monthly Dinner: July 9, August 13, September 10
- Volunteer / Service Event
 - *July 12:* Music & Arts Festival, assist with beverage sales (check IDs, collect payment & serve alcohol) between Noon-7:00pm
 - *August:* Make blankets to support My Very Own Blanket at Toukan & Company
 - *September/October:* Help FACT / Friends of Alum Creek & Tributaries with their service project
