NOTE: Please remember if you cancel after the deadline of November 30, you will be required to pay regardless of your attendance.

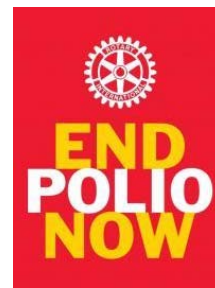
