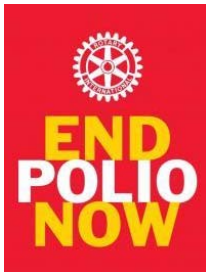

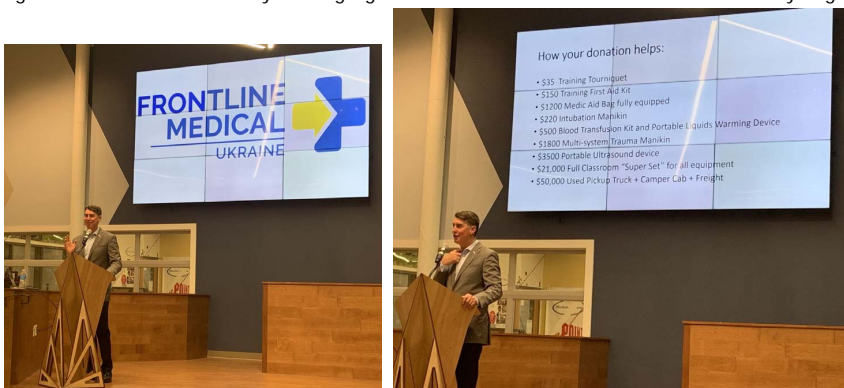

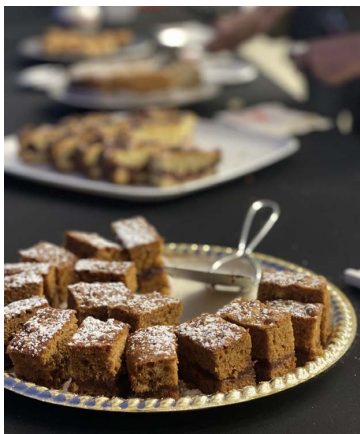


Frontline Medical Ukraine presentation

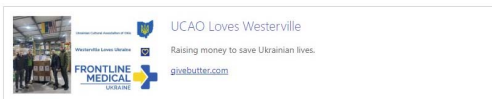
