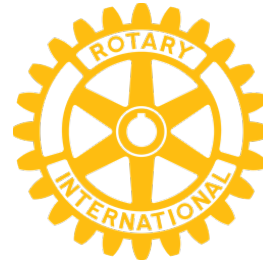

## Membership Initiative: Satellite Club

Growing membership is Rotary's top internal priority. Paul Harris, the founder of Rotary International, famously stated, "This is a changing world; we must be prepared to change with it." Your Club leaders have explored potential membership strategies. Our recommendation: start a Satellite club as an alternative meeting experience for members who cannot regularly attend weekly

meetings.

### ***What is a Satellite Club?***

- Strategy to attract new members (example: teachers, parent/grandparents who drop off students to school, servant leaders who have work conflicts) and retain members
- Extension of our club -- Satellite club members would be Westerville Sunrise Rotarians
- 8 members needed to start a Satellite club - See attached file for information

Club leadership is considering sponsorship of a satellite club. However, the specifics and formal application have not been finalized. When ready, that application and charter will be presented to the board for approval. If approved by the board, we will have a vote of the entire club, following the same voting procedures as the vote on the bylaws. Also of note, satellite clubs must be approved by both the district (6690) and Rotary International.
