Eleanor and I have spent the last five days attending the Rotary International Convention in Calgary, Canada. We have enjoyed our time here with 15,000 fellow Rotarians including members of our club, plus members of District 6690. We attended all the major presentations and learned all about many past and future projects.

A very exciting announcement today was that the Permanent Endowment fund has reached a balance of 2 Billion Dollars. Only the interest earned will go to fund Rotary projects, the principal balance will never be spent. This will allow in the range of \$25,000,000. Dollars per year to support Rotary projects.

We also attended the Rotary Foundation Donor Summit. There were several excellent speakers. The highlight of the presentations was the recognition of seventeen new members of the Arch Klumph Society. This honor is for Rotarians who have reached their contributions over time to at least \$250,000. Dollars. Because they have actually contributed money at this level they will be recognized at the Rotary Headquarters in Evanston and have their photo on the wall along with all the other members of the Arch Klumph Society.

Many Rotarians will plan ahead and leave enough money in their estate planning to be recognized as Arch Klumph Society members.

Our incoming President, Jim Caldwell has asked me to continue this new Rotary year as your club Rotary Foundation Chair. I am honored to do this and to work with our members to help each of you reach your goals in supporting the Rotary Foundation and the PolioPlus project.
