

Through my work with Ohio Literacy Council and Central Ohio Immigrant Support, I met a young couple who escaped Afghanistan during the Taliban takeover. They landed in central Ohio after traveling in several other countries. Both are college educated with bachelor and/or master's degrees in civil engineering and/or business administration.

Language is still a slight problem, but they are reasonably conversant. Having spoken with them several times, I am impressed with their drive and interest in securing positions as quickly as possible here in Central Ohio.

The friend who assisted them in the past has taken a position on the West Coast, so they no longer have contacts here in the area.

At this point, their most prevalent need is transportation to get to interviews and to work once they secure positions. If you have contacts where they may get inexpensive transportation (car) or know of someone who may consider donating a car, I would be glad to serve as a liaison for them. I am also seeking help for them with rent and food.




