He provided an update on efforts to maximize the airport's property for economic development, noting current limitations such as restrictions on building size. Despite those constraints, he highlighted opportunities to expand aviation-related services, including potential hangar development to support specialized work like aircraft painting. These types of investments could position the airport as a stronger regional asset, driving job creation and new economic activity in the Mid-Ohio Valley.

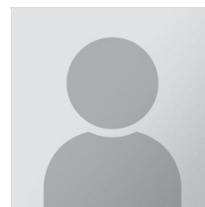
