The Honor Flight Bluegrass is making its final flight of 2022 on Wednesday Sept. 7th. Our Rotary Ground Crew is seeking to add a few members to help the 80 vets from WW II, Korea and Vietnam and their guardians as they check in and board their charter flight to Washington D.C. starting at about 4:15 am in the morning, or to help them get checked out and reunited with their families upon their return. Our help is needed beginning between 4:30 and 7:30 am as they depart and between 7:30 pm and 10:30 pm as they return.
