Next Week's Meeting - David Jones, Jr.



Our meeting on Thursday, November 9th at the University Club will feature **David Jones**, **Jr**. He will discuss the autobiography of **David A**. **Jones**, **Always Moving Forward: A memoir of friends**, **family and building Humana**, which depicts his father's profound impact on American health care, as well as his lifelong engagement in – and perhaps unparalleled impact on – his hometown of Louisville. The book, released on October 10, 2023, was published posthumously; Jones passed away in September 2019 as the initial draft was completed.

David will share the experience of reading accounts of his father's life – both the very public and well-known stories of his entrepreneurial life, as well as lesser-known and intimate moments of his personal life – from the perspective of an author and architect of today's modern health care, as well as from the perspective of his recently deceased father. Joining Jones will be longtime Louisville Courier-Journal columnist and eight-time author Bob Hill, who assisted with the autobiography.


