


Last Week's Meeting Recap - Mayoral Candidate Forum

"Underwater Discoveries from King Herod's Harbor at Caesarea Maritima in Israel."

One of the most historic underwater sites on earth is the ancient harbor of Caesarea Maritima on the Mediterranean coast of Israel, where sunken structures and shipwrecks from Biblical times to the era of the crusaders can still be found and studied today. Archaeologist John Hale has spent many field seasons diving in the waters of Caesarea Harbor, working with an international team that



has discovered ancient cargoes of bronze statues, gold and silver coins, and even swords and other weapons from the time of Richard the Lionheart of England and the Crusades.






If you weren't there, you missed an amazing evening!
