Joy Ovington, Creative Director of the Georgia Fine Arts Academy, hit the stage tapping to "Zip-a-Dee-Doo-Dah" at the age of five. Since then she's logged over four decades of experience performing, teaching, and working all aspects of technical theatre, film and arts administration. She studied Theatre at the Alabama School of Fine Arts, the University of Alabama, where she was an Irene Ryan Award Finalist, and with the National Theatre of Great Britain Summer Acting Programme at Cornell University. She holds a Master of Fine Arts degree from the Florida State University/Asolo Conservatory for Professional Actor Training, where she was inducted into the Society of American Fight Directors, performed with the Asolo Repertory Theatre, and joined film students in winning a College Television Emmy. She's worked with numerous regional theatre companies such as Circle Theatre in Chicago where she was Jeff Award-Nominated, Charlotte Shakespeare Company, Hersheypark Entertainment, Jenny Wiley Theatre, and has won a choral GLAMA award with Windy City Performing Arts. She was a company member of Athens' professional theatre company Circle Ensemble Theatre Company. Joy has emceed events, stage-managed fundraisers and music festivals, and hosted an award-winning talk show on St. Louis' community radio station KDHX. Some favorite posts include managing the Tapis Rouge VIP tent during the Cirque du Soleil's "Dralion" run in St. Louis, being assistant to the E.D. for Montgomery's Jubilee CityFest, and teaching Acting at Auburn University. She spent over ten years in administrative roles at the Athens Regional Library System and is excited to now be the new Creative Director of the Georgia Fine Arts Academy.


