James Williams needs some volunteers to sit at our club's table at the Punta Gorda Farmer's Market on Taylor Street on Saturday morning September 17 and September 24. We will be both promoting our Club and encouraging people to participate in a "digital fundraiser" at local restaurants for Ukrainian relief through the Czestochowa, Poland Rotary Club.

James also announced that the Anna Maria Rotary Club has raises \$50,000, and, together with \$55,00 raised by our Club, \$105,000 is going to Czestochowa.

James obtained a \$25,000 Disaster Response Grant for Ukraine from District 6060, and D6960 appointed our Club's Foundation to handle the distribution of this grant.

Our 'social event" at the Ice House was deemed a success. We will hold another "social event after the first of the year."

There will be a "Meals of Hope" event at Babcock Ranch Rotary Club on Saturday September 17 from 9AM to 11AM. Both meals and water purification systems will be packaged for shipping to Europe for Ukrainian relief. James has further details.
