Critical Issue of Opioid Awareness

It was an incredible privilege to present the critical issue of opioid awareness and demonstrate Naloxone administration at the Maryland and DC Annual Rotary District Conference in Bethesda, Maryland on April 21, 2023. This experience was a full circle moment for me, as I previously served as President of Pikesville Rotary Club in 2018 and led the first opioid and Naloxone training in collaboration with the Baltimore County Health Dept in July of that year. Since then, I have

established a recurring monthly training at the FDA with a team of 17 U.S. Public Health Service Officers, and we have trained over 6,000 people worldwide while working with health departments to dispense Naloxone to participants. Read More



History Moment: Picturing Women Inventors?

The word "inventor" brings to mind images of men like Thomas Edison and Alexander Graham Bell, but inventors come from every demographic and segment of society. The stories of inventive women often have been overlooked, undervalued, and sometimes lost, not least because they have lacked the support and backing necessary to secure patents and develop inventions into marketable products or services. In mid-2019, both houses of Congress held hearings on what lawmakers called the "lost Einsteins," looking at gender gaps in science, engineering, technology, and invention. Patricia Bath, inventor of a surgical instrument for cataract removal, testified: "The pipeline for increasing women scientists and engineers begins by igniting the spark for learning and curiosity." Academic research has confirmed the importance of role models in inspiring invention among girls while also pointing out that, at current rates, it will take more than a century to reach gender parity with male inventors. 1 Read More

Clubs continue to post images and other media (cartoons, songs, etc.) online in disregard of copyright laws, resulting in a considerable increase in claims activity under the U.S. Rotary Club & District Liability Insurance Program ("Program"). **Over 40% of the Program's open claims now pertain to copyright infringement**. Since claims activity determines state-by-state insurance assessment rates, your club could raise the rates for all of the clubs in your state.
