So, how can the Rotary Leadership Institute help?

What is the Rotary Leadership Institute?

- **RLI** is a series of three fast-paced, interactive, courses offered to enhance a **Rotarian's** leadership skills and increase their base of knowledge in **Rotary**.
- Courses are fun, topical, and geared toward active business and professional persons who want to be more effective leaders in their vocations and clubs and more knowledgeable about **Rotary**.

Why is RLI so vital to Rotary's future?

• **RLI** and the knowledge it provides its graduates is the key to the future success of your own **Rotary** club and of **Rotary International.**

How long does RLI take?

- **RLI** is a three-part program, and can be offered online or in-person.
 - > Each part takes one day to complete, sometimes two evenings.
 - Each participating **Rotary** district usually conducts 2-4 **RLI** training sessions each year.
- **Rotarians** may travel to nearby **Rotary** districts to complete the three-part curriculum in a shorter period of time. Some Districts offer online courses.

What does RLI cost?

- Tuition will vary depending on whether the session is online or in-person, and the anticipated material and costs to conduct each session. In in-person sessions should be around \$60.00 (the online cost will be less) for each of the three parts, (some clubs cover this) which includes:
 - > All materials
 - Site costs (included in in-person sessions)
 - Breakfast, lunch and breaks (included in in-person sessions)
 - Administrative costs

So, who should attend RLI?

- <u>"Up-and-coming</u>" **Rotarians** those that club leaders perceive as the "future" of their club and of **Rotary**
- <u>Club leaders</u> who have been elected but have not yet taken office
- <u>ALL Rotarians</u> who are excited about being part of Rotary's potential for good
- Individuals who joined Rotary to make a difference and seek empowerment.

When should a Rotarian attend RLI?

- When the club and the Rotarian want to know more about Rotary beyond the club
- the "up-and-coming" **Rotarian** leader is usually recognized by his/her club and ready for **RLI** within the first 2-3 years; and often sooner

Who benefits from RLI?

- Your club benefits, future leaders benefit, and the entire **Rotary** organization becomes more effective.
- So...EVERYBODY wins!
