Rotary Camelinas Club we received the request to support CRIT MICHOACAN, which is a Mexican foundation dedicated to the support of children and adolescents with disabilities, cancer and autism; since they do not have a specific room for the treatment of children with autism spectrum disorder (sensory integration room with the neurorehabilitation therapy team (CIS)), in which people with other disabilities treated at the CRIT Michoacán Children's Rehabilitation and Inclusion Center can also be attended.

CRIT MICHOACÁN

The Crit Michoacán is located in the city of Morelia, capital of the state of Michoacán, where all children from all over the state, with different disabilities, are attended.



OBJECTIVES

1. Our goal is to achieve the **donation of neurorehabilitation therapy equipment for CRIT Michoacán**, which will allow them to provide adequate and necessary care to children with autism in our state.
2. We will impact the following areas of interest:
 - Prevention and treatment of diseases.
 - Improve the quality of life of children with autism and disability and their families.



BENEFICIARIES

- The impact of the acquisition of this equipment would be directly towards **750** people served, which represents 75% of the total population served in CRIT Michoacán. (Total: 1,007 children and adolescents with neuromusculoskeletal disabilities, of which 60% have approximate monthly incomes of less than 300 USD).
- This number of children attended is renewed as soon as the children are discharged, they give space for a new child who is on the waiting list.

I hereby request your support in the management for the acquisition of a Neurorehabilitation Therapy equipment **Sensory Integration Room (CIS)** and staff training in its use, for the exclusive benefit of people with disabilities, treated at the Teleton Michoacan Children's Rehabilitation and Inclusion Center.

- **Sensory Integration Room (CIS) (\$ 30,767 USD)**

The objectives when acquiring this equipment are the following:

- Provide new proven and effective treatments for child neurological rehabilitation.
- Carry out treatments tailored to the exact size of the people who require it, reducing the number of sessions required to achieve the treatment objectives
- Increase the effectiveness of the rehabilitation treatments granted at CRIT Michoacán. Improve the quality of life of people with disabilities by improving mobility and strength
- Maintain quality and continuous improvement in our Care Model with the use of state-of-the-art equipment.
- Keep our physical therapists updated on the use of new treatment technologies. (The CRIT will economically solve the update that is required for the therapists to make a professional use of the equipment).

The impact of the acquisition of this equipment would be directly towards 750 people, representing 75 % of the total population served in the CRIT Michoacan. (Total: 1007 children and adolescents with neuro-musculoskeletal disabilities, of which 60% have monthly income of approximately less than \$ 300 USD) and people treated on external model.

Once the equipment is acquired, the CRIT will be responsible for enforcing the guarantees that the manufacturer refers to and will add to the Calendar and Logbook of equipment maintenance that is fully carried in the CRIT and that allows the equipment to remain in optimal operation and to prolong its life.
