Did you know that by the end of this year there will be 60 people stung by scorpions in the indigenous community of Las Guayabas? many of them are children and will be in danger of death due to the lack of close medical care...



About "Las Guayabas"

"Las Guayabas" is a Wixarika indigenous community located in the northern highlands of the state of Jalisco.

- Distance to the Nearest City (Colotlán): 8 hours.
- Number of persons in the communitiy: 400
- Number of cases of people stung by scorpions per year: 60
- Number of deaths per year: Between 3 4









Problem:



Families in the community do not have electricity. This not only puts the community at risk of receiving scorpion bites that occur particularly at night but also prevents children from being able to do their schoolwork at night.



Solution

Implement solar panels in the community that can bring light to each family.





Our Goal

Project Scope:

- 1. Implement solar panels in 50 houses in the community in order to decrease the cases of people who are stung by Scorpions.
- 2. Implement water purification plants for the community so they can have access to clean water.
- 3. Implement an isolated system also with solar panels that feed a battery that allows having a refrigerator in the ceremonial center where the antidote against scorpion bites can be had


Rotary Areas of Interest we are covering

General Esquematic of the project












