Community Needs



- a. Mexico has over 130,000 people who suffer from Chronic Renal Insufficiency.
- b. The waiting list for a public sector sponsored transplant is over 12,000 patients and can literally take years.
- c. The cost of a live donor transplant operation in the private sector is prohibitive for a large percentage of the population.
- d. The Holtz-Beahon Kidney Transplant Program is the only option for the people we serve.



Global Grants - Area of Focus Disease Prevention and Treatment



Save the lives of patients with chronic renal insufficiency (CRI), who belong to underprivileged families, have Mexican Government Social Security (With Social Security coverage the patients will receive post-transplant medicines as needed free of charge) and provide their own live kidney donor. Since the first GG, these are the kind of transplant patients we have assisted. (Transplant Type I).
