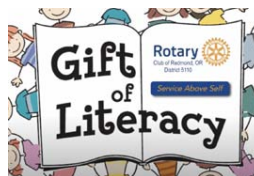
This Week

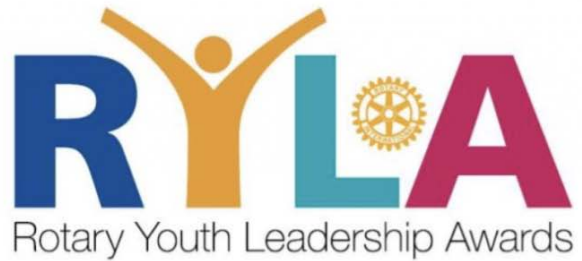
