Linda (Smith) Cline was raised on a farm outside the tiny town of Glendale, Oregon which is located along Interstate 5, between Roseburg and Grants Pass. The



youngest of ten children, she's always enjoyed the attention that goes with being the baby of the family. While the Smiths were quite poor, they had plenty of home-grown meat and produce, and endless fields and forests to explore.

Linda is a graduate from Oregon State University with a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Health and Safety Studies. To scratch her artistic itch, in her forties she completed an Associate's Degree in Graphic Design from Portland Community College. Her resume includes nonprofit executive director, real estate broker, and marketing manager for a legendary Oregon winery. Now, Linda is the City of Redmond's Housing Program Analyst. In this role, she is developing affordable housing opportunities, administering Federal grant funds, and serving as the City's staff liaison to homeless service providers.
