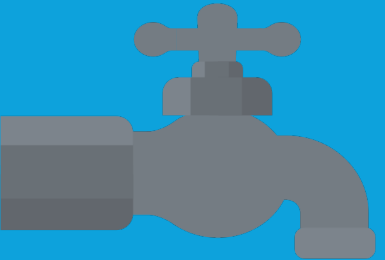

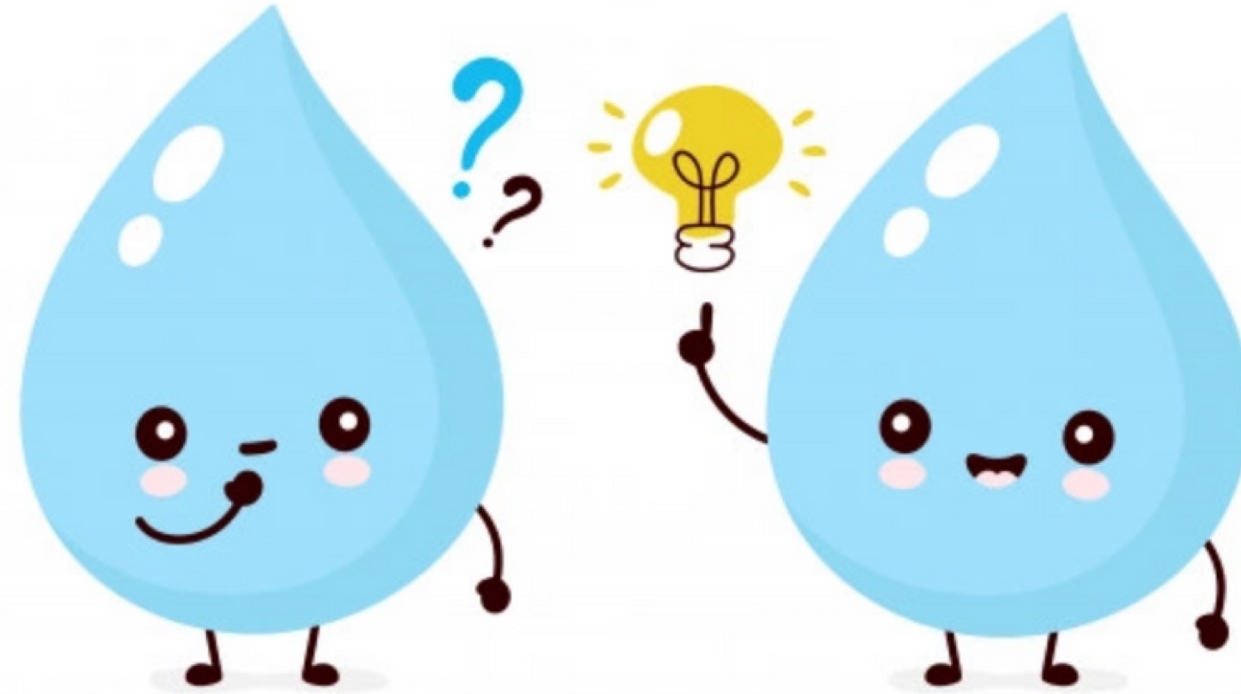

# WHY?



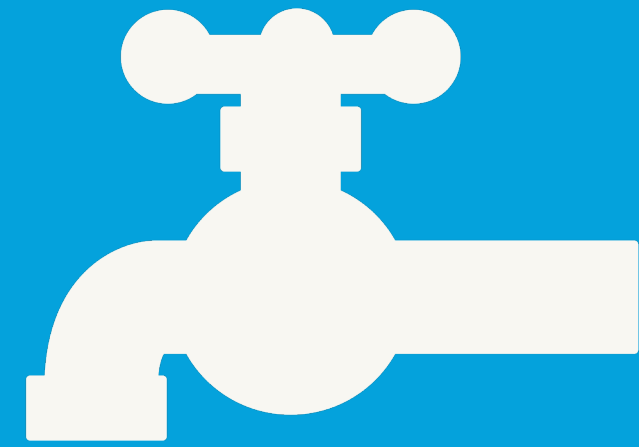
**For this reason, the Rotary Club Retalhuleu will join in the Rotary Challenge Wash in Schools - WINS - project that aims to improve hand washing, hygiene habits and menstrual health of girls and boys to improve their permanence in schools.**

*"Developing a healthy school community goes beyond having a well, clean toilets, and a mural with pictures. For the changes produced to provide long-term benefits in the health of the Community, investment must be made in educational, effective and sustainable health programs that not only encourage good habits but also promote a change in behavior."*

# HOW?

**11 public Schools were visited, in the outskirts of the department of Retalhuleu. Principals, teachers, students and parents were interview.**

**For the project, 8 of the 11 schools were selected. These schools are located in 8 buildings that need infrastructure improvements on washrooms, sinks and installation of water storage containers. In addition, it includes training courses on good hygiene practices.**



# WHAT?



**The project hopes to teach and influence students, teachers and parents to adopt new and healthier practices for the years to come. The long-term goals of this project should be to reduce the incidence of disease, learning improvement and permanence in schools.**
