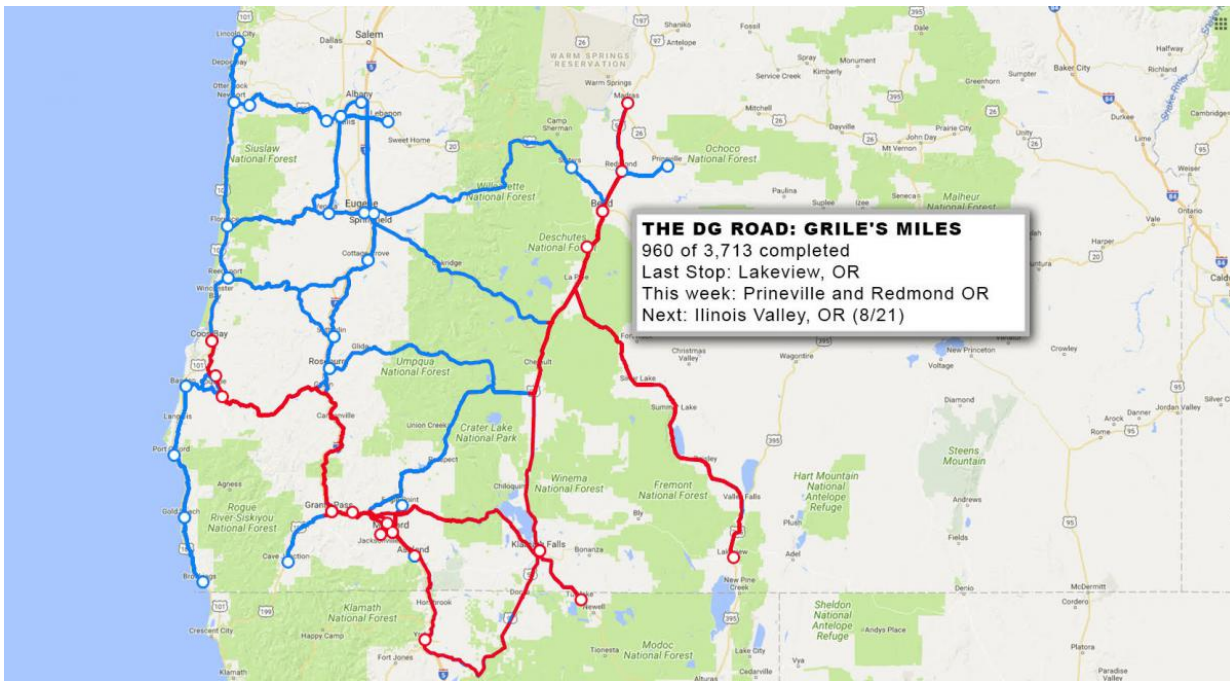

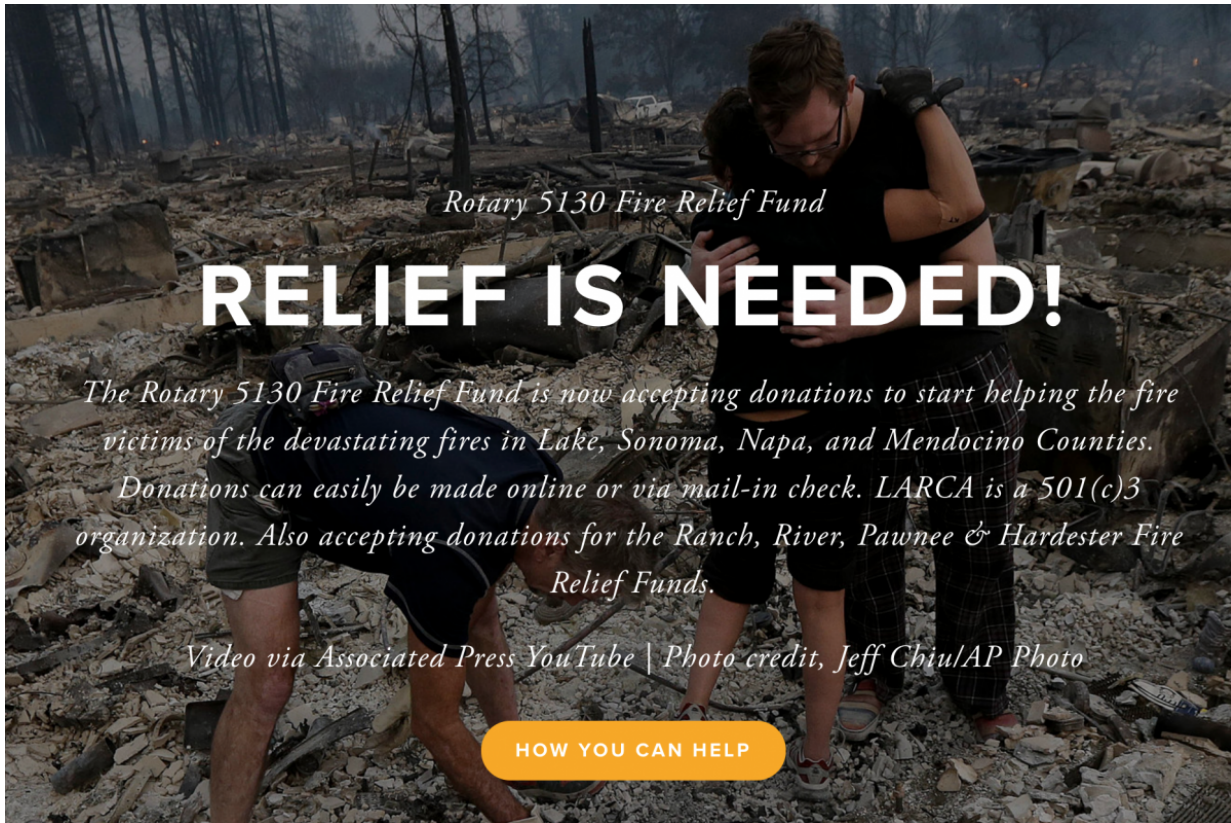

## ANNOUNCING A NEW CLUB IN OUR DISTRICT

There's a new club in our district! All Rotarians are welcome to join and you don't even have to leave your current club. It's called the Triple Crown Club and it has its own pin. We know how much Rotarians love pins.

How do you join this club? It's simple: Be a Paul Harris Society member, a Polio Plus Society member, a Bequest Society Member, and a Major Donor.

To be a Paul Harris Society member you need to give \$1000 each year to TRF. To be a Polio Plus Society member you need to agree to give \$100 each year to Polio eradication (TRF) until Polio is declared GONE. To be a Bequest Society member you need to bequeath \$10,000 or more in your will or trust and to be a Major donor, you need to have contributed \$10,000 or more to TRF (this is cumulative over time

or any combination of TRF actual dollars).
