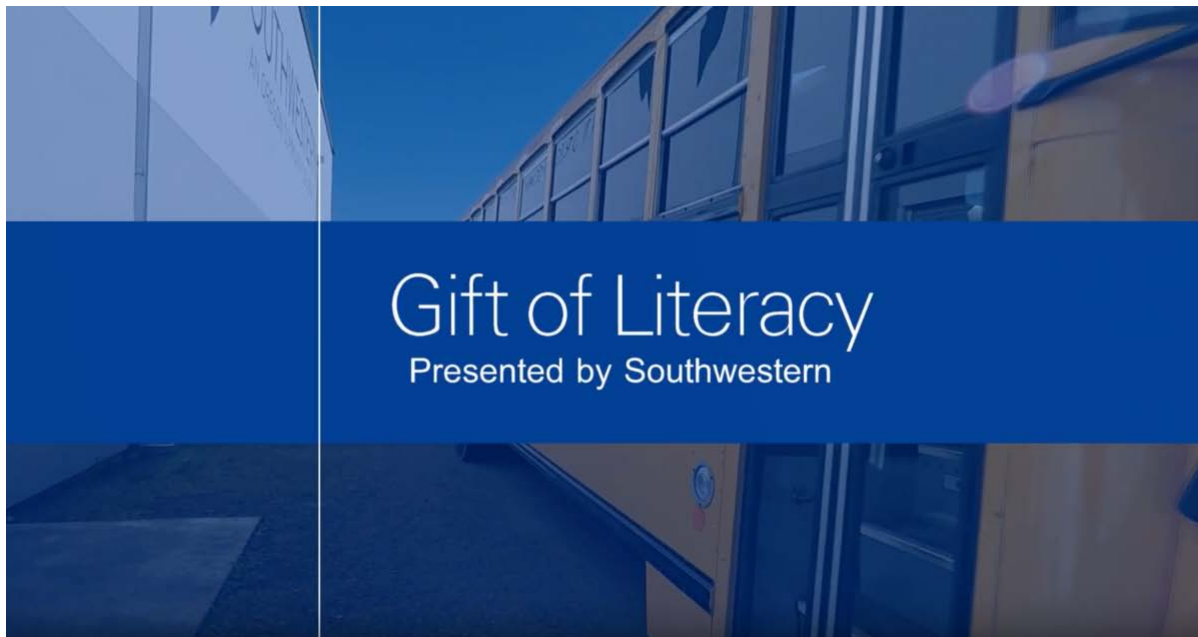

Cyclone Idai made landfall in Mozambique, Malawi, and Zimbabwe on March 14, bringing winds of over 100 mph and heavy rains. Early estimates are that almost one million people have been affected and at least 125,000 have been forced from their

homes in Malawi alone.

ShelterBox is in Malawi talking to local partners in all countries affected to see how we can best help. We expect support will include emergency ShelterKits so families can repair or create shelter, as well as water filters and mosquito nets so families can protect themselves from disease.
