## The Real Gift That Keeps on Giving

Eugene Airport Rotary Club, through its own Eugene Airport Rotary Foundation, recently awarded nearly \$90,000 to local students attending Oregon colleges. Twenty-nine high (29) school students from nine (9) area high schools each received \$2000 scholarships. In addition, the club's program allows continuing students to renew their scholarships up to three times. As a result, an additional thirty (30) continuing students received \$1,000. The club's education foundation was also able to provide two memorial scholarships this year, one honoring the late Cleve Dumdi, a local farmer, and one honoring the late Ellie Dumdi, a long-time Airport Rotarian and former county commissioner.

"In 21 years, our club's foundation has provided nearly \$600,000 in scholarships to deserving young people," said club president Phil Groshong. "The honor of assisting these students in their education is a cherished commitment, and one shared by all Airport Rotarians," he said.

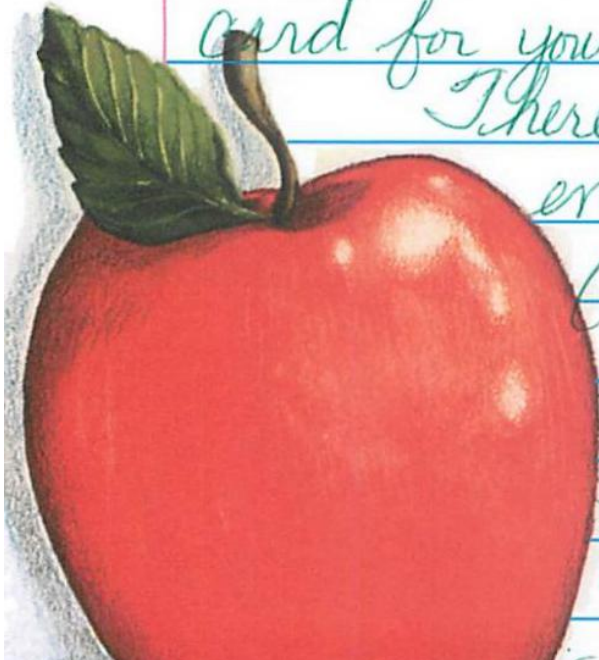
Dear Mr. Friel,
