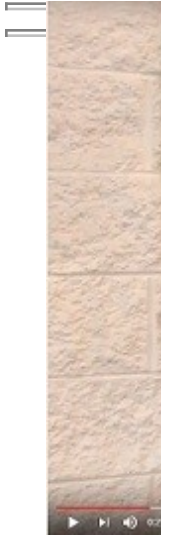

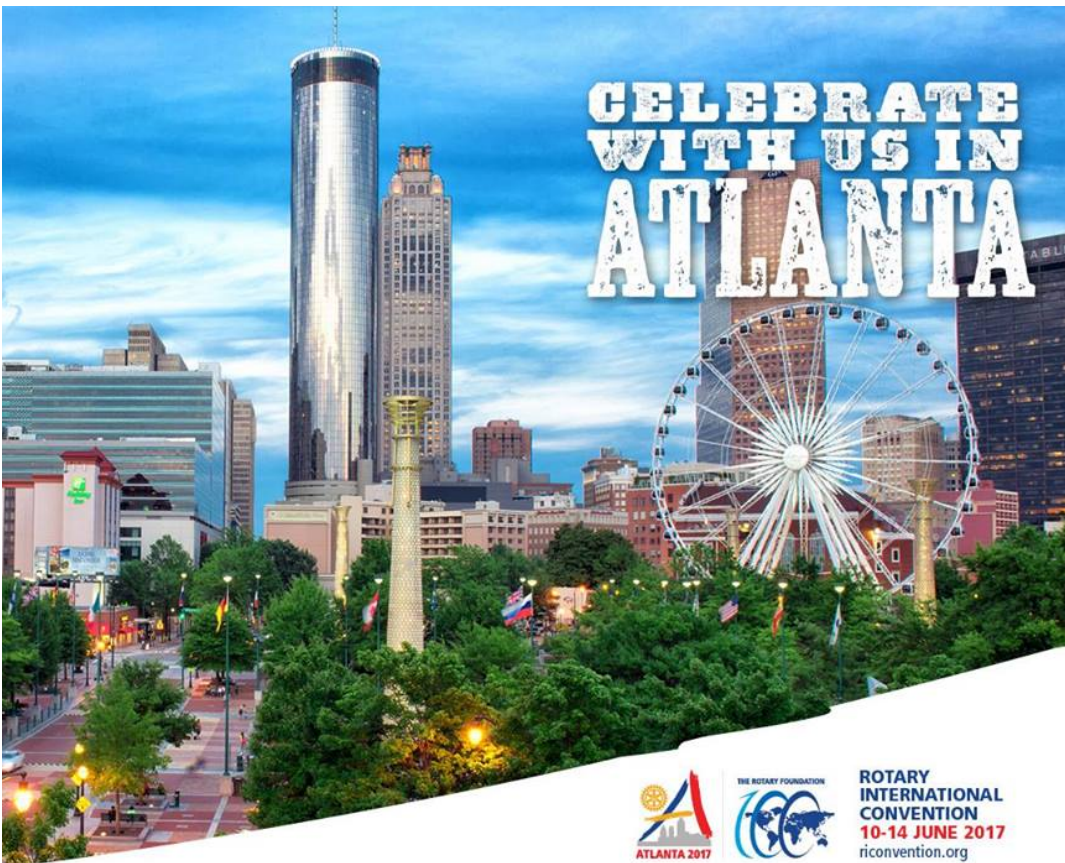

**Polio Eradication Initiative** — a public-private partnership that includes  
e Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and  
n (CDC), the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations  
s Fund (UNICEF) — the incidence of polio has plummeted by more than 99.9  
rom about 350,000 cases a year in 1988 to just 37 confirmed in 2016. Rotary,  
matching funds from the Gates Foundation, has donated \$1.6 billion to polio  
on.

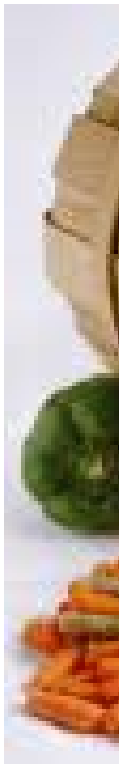

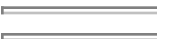
