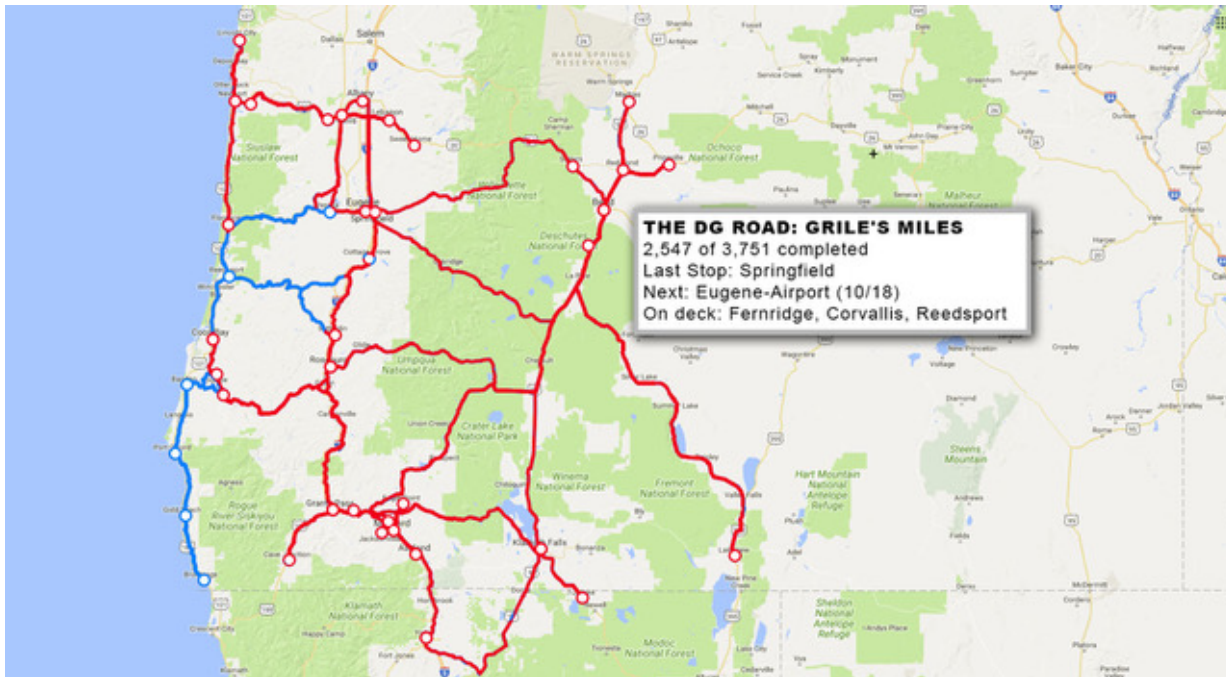

DISTRICT 5110 4-WAY TEST SPEECH CONTEST

If your club is eager to engage youth, promote ethical behavior, and advance the mission of Rotary, then the District 5110 4-Way Test Speech Contest is just what you need. It is an annual event where your club level winning student will compete for cash prizes at the May 4, 2019 District Conference luncheon at the Mill Casino in Coos Bay, Oregon. The First Place winner will receive a check for \$3,500! The 4-Way Test Speech Contest is open to all public, private or homeschool high school age students, grades 9-12. It requires each participating student to create and

present a 5-7 minute speech on a subject of their choice, applying the 4-Way Test to guide their thinking and presentation.

The first step is establishing a relationship with your local high school, usually the principal or language arts teachers. Inform them of the event and schedule a date for your club level student completion. If you or a member of your club would like to assist in the staging of this event at the May 2019 District Conference, let me know.

Everything you need to promote your contest and achieve a successful event will be available beginning November 1 in DACdb. (see 4-Way Test Speech Contest resources under the "files" menu).

Do you know how to join this club?

It's simple: Be a Paul Harris Society member, a Polio Plus Society member, a Bequest Society Member, and a Major Donor.

To be a Paul Harris Society member you need to give \$1000 each year to TRF. To be a Polio Plus Society member you need to agree to give \$100 each year to Polio eradication (TRF) until Polio is declared GONE. To be a Bequest Society member you need to bequeath \$10,000 or more in your will or trust and to be a Major donor, you need to have contributed \$10,000 or more to TRF (this is cumulative over time or any combination of TRF actual dollars).
