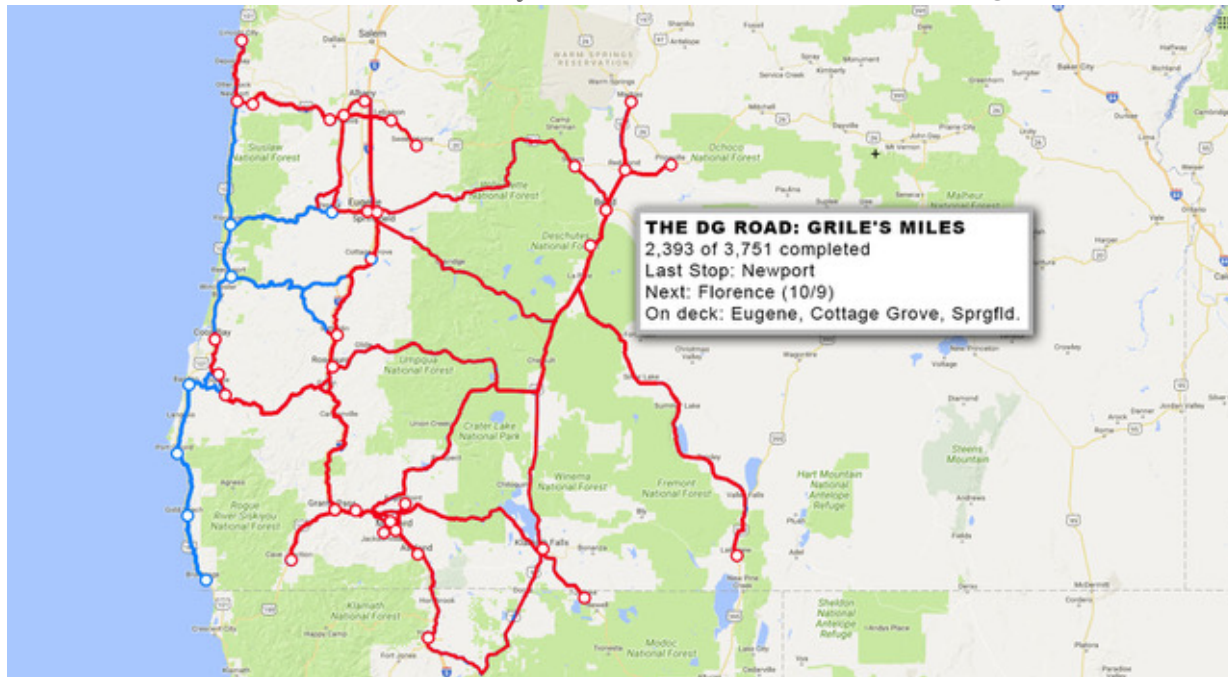

SHELTERBOX & ROTARY RESPOND TO INDONESIAN EARTHQUAKE, TSUNAMI

Sulawesi, Indonesia has been devastated.

On Friday, September 28th, a 7.5 magnitude earthquake and tsunami with 10 foot-high waves devastated the Indonesian island of Sulawesi. Over 12,000 people have died and more than 50,000 have been made homeless due to this disastrous event. We also know that water is in short supply and that the infrastructure has been badly damaged.

ShelterBox already has a Response Team in Lombok, Indonesia following the August 6.9 magnitude earthquake

which left 20,000 people homeless. Our team has been in-country for the last month helping families recover from that event. We are now sending a second Response Team to Indonesia to understand how we might be able to help Sulawesi families who have lost everything.

Past District Governor Tim Mobley would like to plan this trip through a travel

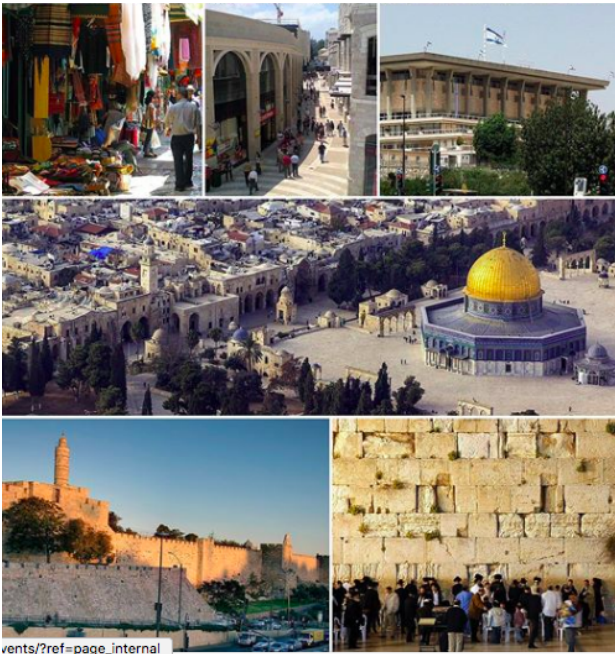
