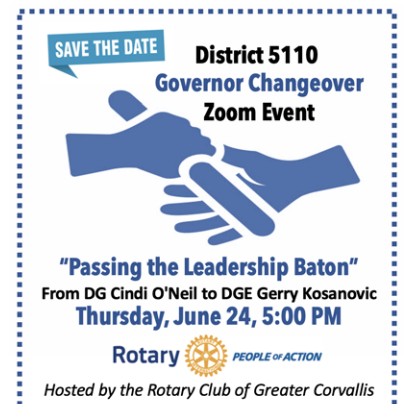
The June 24th District Governor Baton Pass
