**Secretary's Report:** It was reported that our attendance for February was 81% which is inflated as DACdb gives attendance credit for Rule of 85 whether they attend or not . We average 40 actual attendees. The balance in our Operating account is \$47,099, about \$19k of which is from Greater Giving and will be redirected to the Crab Feed account and the Crab Feed is \$47,355 Additionally, **Bill Gunter** & **Gary** will move the cart back over to St Rose and Bill will replace the wheels so the bloody thing will roll! Thank you Bill!

**Treasurer's Report: Barbara Larson** shared that the Community Fund restricted account was down about \$4k due to "a change in value" – aka the market went down. The Club operations account is in good shape.

# **President Chris's Report:**

- President Chris proposed that we donate two \$2000 scholarships to Roseland Collegiate Prep students. After much discussion it was agreed that we would consult with Bob Zeni on the process used at Piner and also become involved in the selection process moving forward. On a motion by **Janet Codding** and a second by **Susan Nowacki** the motion was passed. It was also determined that we would explore the possibility of hanging the Rotary wheel at RCP in recognition of our sponsorship
